Thank you again for the privilege of talking with you today relative to your Camp Pinnacle property.

I understand that you are referring our proposal to your Board of Directors at their next meeting April 28th.

After talking with you today I ventured out to your property in ten inches of heavy snow. I walked directly to the very spot we talked about - at the corner of the ridge just off of the Pinnacle road to the east of your "lookout" point. In this spot our little building and tower would be quite well isolated from any of your activities and I am certain would in no way be detrimental.
