
accompanied by Mr. Maynard, engineer for the New York Telephone Company, I completed with him yesterday the over-all tracing of the proposed new hi-fidelity (15,000 cycle) line which is now under consideration to serve the Heldeberg mountains.

I talked with other telephone executives also and was assured that this new line will be constructed to give us full hi-fidelity quality for programming, thus obviating the necessity for constructing an S-T radio relay link. We will receive shortly a complete proposition from the telephone people embracing the use of this proposed new line.

I saw evidence of work started by Kampf, the surveyor for Mr. La Grange. They have established the lines in the Pinnacle Road and today will work back into the tract and probably complete the job by Friday or Saturday. I would like to suggest that if it is your intention to prove La Grange's property line as distinct from the Pinnacle property that you engage Kampf to follow through for you. He would have the advantage of knowing the ground as the result of his current operations on the mountain. It would save time.

La Grange is ready to convey immediately he gets Kampf's report. Incidentally you might get an early expression from Barron of how the Commission will react to this site.
