Attached is copy of my confirming letter to Miss Mary A. Rogers of the Albany Bible School.

It would hardly be right to have him on hand during our negotiations with the Camp Pinnacle people. The fact that Miss Rogers and members of her Board of Directors have agreed to visit the property with us is obviously indicative that at least they are receptive to our proposal.

If we can acquire use of this property for our site, it would be a wonderful break for the Troy Record. Let's hope we make the grade.
