One of my clients, The Troy Record Company, Troy, N. Y., will shortly be in the market for an FM antenna support for their new frequency modulation station. We will use a 4-Bay General Electric FM antenna.

Our over-all height including the 4-Bay antenna will be 100 ft. The GE antenna measures approximately 42 ft. Hence, the support will be about 58 ft. or whatever the physical difference will be allowing for the mast fitting into the support sufficiently deep to make a strong mounting. A guyed tower will answer the purpose.

Please include with your quotation all erection accessories including guys, etc. Also include necessary mounting fixtures for taking the GE 4-Bay antenna mast, 300 M/M beacon flasher and necessary obstruction lights.
